I'm reaching out to you on behalf of a new women's organization on campus called Texas A&M Legacies. Legacies is a leadership organization that revolves around the pillars of **Passion**, **Honor**, and **Community**, and focuses on developing women and girls of all ages.

Legacies was established by a group of young women who all had the same idea – they all wanted to have an impact at Texas A&M, give back to our community, and encourage other women. In order to make their dreams a reality, they decided to form a new women's organization. We are striving to create a legacy of service and leadership through the empowerment of women both within the TAMU student body and Bryan-College Station community, in keeping with TAMU's core values of service and leadership. We set ourselves apart from other current women's organizations in two main ways:

- Serving others through mentoring younger girls and collaborating with women in the community in ways including (but not limited to) a sustained mentorship program at local high schools, spending time with women in retirement communities, and volunteering with Aggieland Pregnancy Outreach.
- Planning opportunities to encourage and allow leadership development, including coprogramming with existing organizations (smaller events) and the organizing of a women's leadership conference on campus (major event).

We want all of our members to feel empowered to express themselves and to encourage other women to do the same. With that in mind, we hold all of our members to high standards, and all of the women in Legacies are called to represent our organization and university in the most remarkable way. Legacies is a women's leadership organization that, through personal development, philanthropy, and community-building efforts, seeks to unite and encourage passionate female leaders.
