Final Exam Goody Bags will include a charging kit, bag, your choice of goodies contributed by participating moms, and fresh fruit for \$8 including tax.




We will assemble the bags at the end of the April 23 general meeting for distribution on Monday, April 27, on the College Station campus in the MSC or for you to take with you.






DCAM COVID-19 UPDATE
