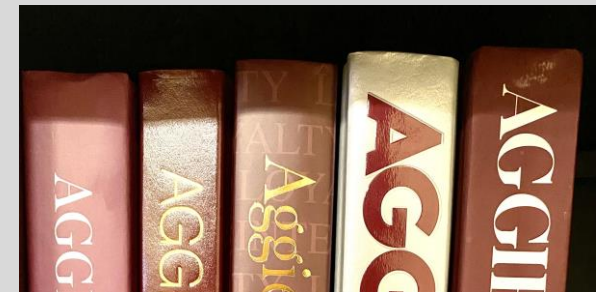

PROGRAM AREAS

Director's Office

Provides administrative oversight for the supporting offices within Student Life. This oversight includes budget, human resources, marketing and communications, facilities management and general departmental outreach including resource tables.



Alcohol & Other Drug Education

- Promotes responsible drinking behaviors and reducing alcohol and other substance misuse among students.
- Provides educational workshops, peer-led discussions, and outreach campaigns to raise awareness about the risks associated with excessive alcohol consumption.
- Offers resources and support services for students seeking help with substance-related issues.



Graduate & Professional Student Government

Exists to work in cooperation with Texas A&M University and to bring a voice to the needs of graduate and professional students through advocacy, outreach, and research.



Interpersonal Violence Prevention

- Includes education and outreach initiatives that increase awareness promote healthy relationships and prevent harm.
- Collaborative in-house workshops, peer education, and consultations, that empower students to build healthy relationships, practice prevention and harm-reduction strategies, and build a proactive culture in Aggieland that values non-violence.



Off Campus Student Services

- Provides education and guidance to help students navigate off-campus living in a manner that supports their wellbeing and academic success.
- Assists students in addressing challenges and building positive relationships with the university and the Aggieland community.
- Supports students and stakeholders through educational workshops and events, outreach programs, mediation services, and individual consultations.



Student Assistance Services

- Connects students with guidance, resources, and support for personal and academic matters.
- Serves as an initial point of contact for information on various topics.
- Common issues include referrals, resource connections, behavior follow-up, student absence notifications, Silver Taps, student death, and transition-related concerns.



Student Legal Services

- Provides one-on-one free legal advice and assistance to students.
- Topics include landlord/tenant disputes, criminal law, expunctions, automobile accidents, traffic tickets, and consumer protection.
- Provides, mediation services are available to help students resolve conflicts.



New Student & Family Programs

- Assists new undergraduate students as they transition to Texas A&M while supporting families of all undergraduate students.
- Creates opportunities that lead to successful student transition, retention, and persistence to graduation.

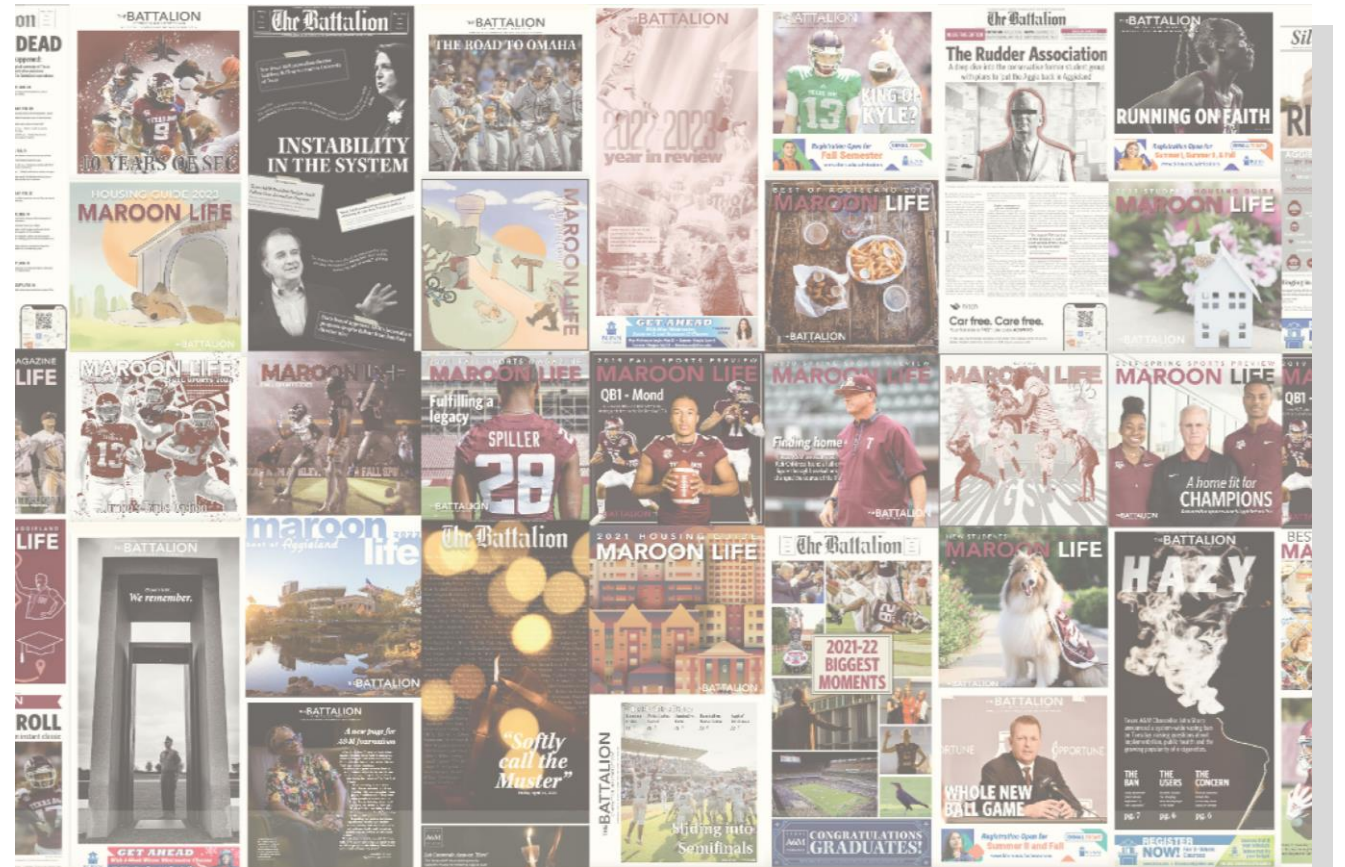
